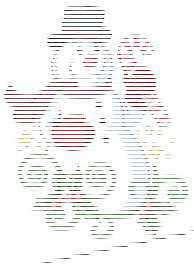

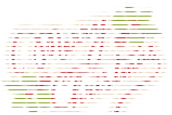


It's hard to believe we're in the final month of 2018 and yet we're still running full steam ahead with projects and planning. The City's 2019 Balanced Budget of \$48.4M has been submitted to Celina City Council for final approval as we enter another year of progress with our Street Program and the new Lakeshore Drive Park District development.

While we've been fortunate to receive several grants for multiple City projects, including both streets and parks, we also have had several individuals and businesses wishing to donate for the new Lakeshore Drive park area and to be a part of this exciting, once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for our community! To facilitate donations, the City has partnered with the Mercer County Civic Foundation to create "The Lakeshore Park District Fund". # RESIDENTIAL LEAF COLLECTION

# Celina Utilities Shut-off Policy

**The City of Celina residential leaf pickup will begin on October 22, 2018 and run weekly through December 14, 2018.**

- Leaves are collected Tuesday through Friday in accordance with the established schedule and as weather conditions allow.
- Leaves must be placed at the curb, not in the street or across sidewalks.
- Avoid parking vehicles in the street during the collection period in your area. Do not park cars in or adjacent to any pile(s) of leaves.
- Do not mix branches with leaves. Limbs and branches collection will not begin until spring 2019.



## **LEAF PICKUP SCHEDULE**

<b>TUESDAY</b>	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street north.
<b>WEDNESDAY</b>	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street south.
<b>THURSDAY</b>	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street south.
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street north.

Prompt payment of your utility bills to avoid getting your services shut off is important. Any customer with a past-due account balance is subject to disconnect. Customers can determine their account status by checking their monthly utility bill. If your bill indicates you are in disconnect status, prompt payment is necessary to avoid having your utilities turned off. Payments can be made to the Celina Utilities office with cash, check, automatic deduction from your bank account, or credit card. A night deposit box is located outside of the front doors for payment after working hours.

**Any customer who has had their utilities turned off due to nonpayment, must make payment with cash or money order to be reconnected.**
