

We've come through the Winter and are now into the fresh days of Spring! With the warming temperatures, children are venturing outside to play and enjoy the outdoors. Sometimes, adults are in such a hurry to go from point "A" to point "B", they tend to forget about Speed Limits. Unless otherwise posted, all Speed Limits in the City, and specifically residential areas, are 25MPH. Speed Limits are established by the Ohio Department of Transportation under State Law.

As a Community, we have several long-awaited projects ahead this year. Our Street Program starts with completing 2018 projects and starting the following 2019 projects:

### Resurfacing:

- East Livingston Street from Fountain Avenue to Grand Lake Road (2,550 feet)
- Fountain avenue from Livingston Street to Wayne Street (857 feet)
- Vine Street from Market Street to Livingston Street (490 feet)
- Anthony Street from Riley to College Avenue (4,570 feet)
- Elm Street from south of Schunk Road to Logan Street (2,712 feet)
- Portland Street from Logan to Market (1,450 feet)

Total Resurfacing Cost: \$634,610.00

### Reconstruction:

- East Livingston Street from Main Street to Fountain Avenue (.53 miles)
- Cost: \$1,218.40

Total miles of Street Projects is 2.92 miles. As always, all motorists and pedestrians should be aware of construction projects and avoid traveling in those areas when possible.

## 2019 Special Trash Collection

The items to be included in this special collection are general household discards **from city residences only**. Because of escalating cost, landfill restrictions and the use of packer trucks for collection, the following regulations and prohibited items will be strictly enforced for this collection. **Each residence will be limited to a maximum of 60 cubic feet of discards**, this is equal to the amount that can be put at one time into the hopper of the collection truck.

Please note the following items are prohibited and will not be collected: **mattresses, appliances, refrigerators, stoves, water heaters, stools, sinks, tires, batteries, tree limbs and brush, leaves, yard waste, railroad ties, building materials that are not boxed or bundled, concrete, brick and stone debris, metal fencing, motor blocks, transmissions and auto body parts, pressure containers, liquid waste and hazardous materials including paint and motor oils. Paint cans must be empty and/or paint dried out.** Special tags are available for separate disposal of these items. Tags can be purchased at the Celina utilities Office any time.

The special trash collection will be held Saturday of each week per the following schedule:

- **Saturday, April 6; the regular Monday route**
- **Saturday, April 13; the regular Tuesday route**
- **Saturday, April 20; the regular Thursday route**
- **Saturday, April 27; the regular Friday route**

In order to participate in this collection, your trash must be placed adjacent the street by 6:30 a.m. the day your area is scheduled for pickup. There will be no callbacks or extension of pickup dates.

An effort should be made by all to keep our community looking neat. No items should be placed out more than 72 hours in advance of your scheduled pickup day. Any resident with trash lying out before the Wednesday prior to their pickup date will be cited.

Materials not collected because they were set out too late or on the wrong day or did not follow the regulations herein stated will be the responsibility of the property owner to dispose of. The City and/or contractors shall not accept responsibility for lost or misplaced items.

Non-city residents found dumping trash within the city and/or scavengers will be cited for littering.

**REMEMBER: It must be boxed, bagged or tied in a bundle that can be picked up by one person, or it will not be picked up.**

## Brush & Limb Pickup



The City's residential limbs and brush collection will begin Monday, April 1st and be conducted on the first Monday of the month through October.

Only limbs and brush without root balls will be collected. Limbs and brush are not to be placed adjacent to the street earlier than three (3) days prior to the scheduled collection, nor after the street has been collected. An effort should be made by all to keep our community looking neat. Limbs must be stacked in piles with larger sections of limbs facing the same direction.

**A three cubic yard limit** has been established for each residence per pickup. That is equal to a pile three feet wide by three feet high by nine feet long.

Brush and limbs in excess of the three cubic yard limit will not be collected and are the responsibility of the property owner to dispose of.

City crews will make only one trip through the City each month and, once your neighborhood is collected, will not return until the next regularly scheduled collection. You are prohibited from putting brush, limbs or debris on the street.

**IF YOU HAVE YOUR TREES TRIMMED, YOUR CONTRACTOR MUST REMOVE THE LIMBS/BRUSH.**
