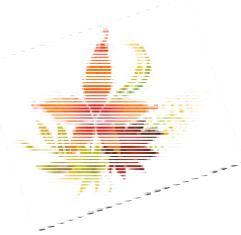

## Brush & Limb Pickup



The City's residential limbs and brush collection will begin Monday, April 1st and be conducted on the first Monday of the month through October.

Only limbs and brush without root balls will be collected. Limbs and brush are not to be placed adjacent to the street earlier than three (3) days prior to the scheduled collection, nor after the street has been collected. An effort should be made by all to keep our community looking neat. Limbs must be stacked in piles with larger sections of limbs facing the same direction.

A **three cubic yard limit** has been established for each residence per pickup. That is equal to a pile three feet wide by three feet high by nine feet long.

Brush and limbs in excess of the three cubic yard limit will not be collected and are the responsibility of the property owner to dispose of.

City crews will make only one trip through the City each month and, once your neighborhood is collected, will not return until the next regularly scheduled collection. You are prohibited from putting brush, limbs or debris on the street.

IF YOU HAVE YOUR TREES TRIMMED, YOUR CONTRACTOR MUST REMOVE THE LIMBS/BRUSH.

# 2019 Fire Hydrant Flushing Schedule

- **September 30th thru October 9th**  
~West of Main Street and continue into West Jefferson Township
- **October 9th thru October 18th**  
~East of Main Street and continue into East Jefferson Township

**\*\*\*Flushing will take place between\*\*\*  
\*\*7:30AM and 4:00PM\*\***

City of Celina is conducting a comprehensive flushing program to insure fire hydrants are operational and to clear out minerals that have accumulated in the city's water pipes. The flushing is accomplished by inspecting and opening fire hydrants fully. This is necessary to maintain the integrity of the distribution system and improve water quality.

Water service may be interrupted. If you see flushing in your area, it is recommended that you not use water for 1-2 hours to allow the system to clear. If water appears discolored, don't be alarmed. Run cold water through a faucet (exterior or bathtub preferred) approximately 5 minutes, to verify water has cleared.

If the water does not clear within a few hours, notify the Utility Office by calling 419-586-2311, Monday-Friday between 8 AM and 5 PM.

The market is in full swing, with 29 registered vendors. Although the inclement weather has had an effect on local produce, our farmers bring fresh, local produce each week. Their crops were planted later than usual (except for greenhouse plants), but tomatoes will be ready by early July & local sweet corn should be ready in mid August. Vendors offer a wide variety of goods including local produce; microgreens; plants & flowers; homemade & home baked foods; kernel corn made fresh at the market from local corn; eggs from cage-free hens; a variety of meat cuts from responsibly raised cows & hogs; local honey; all natural soaps & body products; essential oils; dog accessories & home baked treats; custom designed note cards & signs; dream catchers & wire trees; hand spun yarn & wool products; artisan jewelry & more.
