TRICK OR TREAT

We are fully into Fall as temperatures are dropping and leaves are changing colors. The Fall Holidays are starting and Halloween will be different this year with only Trick-or-Treat and, in some limited cases, "Trunk or Treating", which will be offered by some area businesses and church organizations. Unfortunately, the Ohio Department of Health has ruled that parades and other gatherings are cancelled as a result of the difficulty of maintaining social distancing. So, whether you choose to participate in "Trick-or-Treating" or "Trunk-or-Treating", you are reminded to wear facial coverings (in addition to a costume), social distance with others not part of your family, and frequently use hand-sanitizer to help destroy harmful bacteria from passing. Those handing out candy should do so with precautions to avoid unnecessary physical contact, such as using a "slide" or tube to deliver a treat to "Trick-or-Treaters". According to the CDC and the Ohio State Board of Health, wearing a face mask is necessary to help prevent the spread of COVID. Stay safe while having fun!

Recently, approximately 200 feet of west Market Street had to be ground out and resurfaced by the contractor to comply with ODOT requirements. The majority of City projects have now been completed for the year with the exception of the resurfacing project recently awarded to the Shelly Company. The repaving of nearly 3 miles of street surfaces will commence in the Spring of 2021 when temperatures are warmer.

Please be aware of school zones and abide by restricted speed limits to protect our children as they go to and from school in the mornings and afternoons. Be patient as children cross streets.

Please make an effort to respect others by maintaining safe practices, such as through self-quarantining if you are sick or running a fever, social distancing, and wearing of facial coverings. If you are tested for COVID-19, you must stay home until you receive your results. If you test positive, you are required to follow Health Department Guidelines and remain in quarantine until released by the Health Department, but at least 10 days.

2020 Fire Hydrant Flushing Schedule

- **September 28th thru October 7th**
~West of Main Street and continue into West Jefferson Township
- **October 7th thru October 16th**
~East of Main Street and continue into East Jefferson Township

***** Flushing will take place between *****
****7:30 AM and 4:00 PM****

The City of Celina is conducting a comprehensive flushing program to insure fire hydrants are operational and to clear out minerals that have accumulated in the city's water pipes. The flushing is accomplished by inspecting and opening fire hydrants fully. This is necessary to maintain the integrity of the distribution system and improve water quality.

Water service may be interrupted. If you see flushing in your area, it is recommended that you not use water for 1-2 hours to allow the system to clear. If water appears discolored, don't be alarmed. Run **cold** water through a faucet (exterior or bathtub preferred) approximately 5 minutes, to verify water has cleared.

If the water does not clear within a few hours, notify the Utility Office by calling 419-586-2311, Monday thru Friday between 8 AM and 5 PM.

RESIDENTIAL LEAF COLLECTION

The City of Celina residential leaf pickup will begin on October 20, 2020 and run weekly through December 11, 2020.

- Leaves are collected Tuesday through Friday in accordance with the established schedule and as weather conditions allow.
- Leaves must be placed at the curb.
- Avoid parking vehicles in the street during the collection period in your area. Do not park cars in or adjacent to any pile(s) of leaves.
- Do not mix branches with leaves. Limbs and branches collection will not begin until Spring 2021.

LEAF PICKUP SCHEDULE



- TUESDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street north.
- WEDNESDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street south.
- THURSDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street south.
- FRIDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street north.
