## Snow Removal

Once again the Winter season is approaching. With it comes snow and ice.

You can assist with snow removal in several ways:



- \* Residents are not to blow or shovel snow into city streets or allow private contractors hired to plow their driveways to do so.
- \* All vehicles must be moved from the street when an accumulation of snow is expected to allow plowing while preventing vehicles from being buried or damaged.
- \* For safety, stay as far away from snow plows as possible.
- \* Keep children away from snow plows.
- \* Keep parked cars off the street during snow events.
- \* Do not attempt to pass a snow plow.
- \* Do not attempt to drive through deep snow.
- \* Keep sidewalks clear of snow and ice.

To provide a more thorough and quicker snow removal service, residents are reminded not to park their vehicles on the street after a snowfall.

By Ordinance, residents and businesses are required to keep their sidewalks in repair and free of ice, snow, debris, and obstructions.

## January 2021

While our Holiday season has been a bit subdued, we still have much for which to be thankful. During this past year, the COVID-19 Pandemic triggered nation-wide, government-mandated shutdowns, many businesses reduced their hours of operation or changed how they did business, production decreased, people were laid off, but our community saw this challenge and chose to move forward.

We have closed the challenging chapter of 2020 as we begin 2021!

In spite of bumps in the road, our City continued to serve you and proceeded with critical Water Treatment Plant improvements, roadway repairs and repaving, and are looking forward to a very productive infrastructure "improvement" year with the repaving of nearly 3 miles of streets while planning the next major street reconstruction for 2022. The City has remained financially sound and will continue to set necessary funds aside for projects.

As earlier reported, The City was awarded a \$500,000 Grant from the National Park Service through ODNR for the Bryson Park District. We have again applied for an additional \$500,000 Grant from the national Park Service for improvements to include Westview and Eastview Parks. While the pandemic halted Parks improvements for most of 2020, design plans have been completed for restroom facilities, the Lion's Club Shelter House, playgrounds, Pickle Ball & Volley Ball Courts, along improved basketball courts, to name a few. Our Parks are being developed into first class amenities for our residents and visitors! Stay tuned!

# Celina Utilities Shut-off Policy



Prompt payment of your utility bills to avoid getting your services shut off is important. Any customer with a past-due account balance is subject to disconnect. Customers can determine their account status by checking their monthly utility bill. If your bill indicates you are in disconnect status, prompt payment is necessary to avoid having your utilities turned off.

Payments can be made to the Celina Utilities office with cash, check, automatic deduction from your bank account, or credit card. A night deposit box is located outside of the front doors for payment after working hours.
