



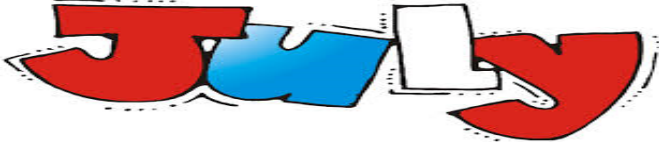

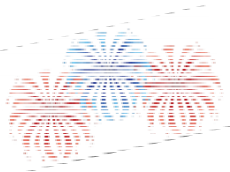

Lake Festival, Concert in the Park Series, monthly Downtown Events, the Grand Lake Marathon, and the Mercer County Fair are all great events to keep on your calendar and are what makes Celina's summertime fun! Be a part of the community and see what all we have to offer!

If you will remember, a few short years ago, the City received a \$8.2M Drinking Water Solutions Grant from the Ohio EPA to address long-term water quality solutions for the City's drinking water. After intensive source investigation and method testing for the most effective approach, the City has constructed a state-of-the-art "pre-treatment" process that significantly removes lake water solids and algae prior to actual treatment. This new process has resulted in using less chemicals to treat and produce drinking water. The contractor was ahead of schedule and the new process has been online for the last month. After calculating costs, it has been determined that no Water rate increases are needed for these capital improvements! Another "win" for Celina's customers.

During the last billing cycle, all Celina Electric customers received a one-time, lump sum credit of approximately \$0.055 per kwh on your June billing statement. Starting with your July billing through the end of the year, all customers will continue to receive a \$0.0025 per kwh on each month's bill. With lower power supply costs, City Administration and Council are currently enacting legislation to lower all rate classes rates by the Fall of this year.

While the Governor has rescinded most of COVID-19 restrictions, including masks for those that have been fully vaccinated, you should be mindful of washing hands often and, if you become ill or begin running a fever, please contact your health care provider and stay home in quarantine until cleared by your physician.

Brush & Limb Pickup



The City’s residential limbs and brush collection will begin Monday, April 5th and be conducted on the first Monday of the month through October.

Only limbs and brush without root balls will be collected. Limbs and brush are not to be placed adjacent to the street earlier than three (3) days prior to the scheduled collection, nor after the street has been collected. An effort should be made by all to keep our community looking neat. Limbs must be stacked in piles with larger sections of limbs facing the same direction.

A **three cubic yard limit** has been established for each residence per pickup. That is equal to a pile three feet wide by three feet high by nine feet long.

Brush and limbs in excess of the three cubic yard limit will not be collected and are the responsibility of the property owner to dispose of.

City crews will make only one trip through the City each month and, once your neighborhood is collected, will not return until the next regularly scheduled collection. You are prohibited from putting brush, limbs or debris on the street.

IF YOU HAVE YOUR TREES TRIMMED, YOUR CONTRACTOR MUST REMOVE THE LIMBS/BRUSH.
