We are excited to know that Dunkin Donuts has broke ground for their new facility on Havemann Road in front of Menards. The new Pizzeria at Walnut and Fayette continues to near completion and another business is soon to begin renovations in the refurbished Lininger Building downtown Celina.

While street projects have completed for 2021, City Council is currently working with new legislation to appropriate funds for nearly 10 miles of street resurfacing in 2022. A new basketball court has been funded through our Grant and will be constructed in the Spring of 2022 along Elm Grove Street. The Bryson Park District along Lake Shore Drive now has 3 Zip Lines for kids of all ages! A newly completed playground was added with even more activities for our children! To top off the playground improvements, a new restroom facility is under construction next to the splash pad.

2021 Fire Hydrant Flushing Schedule



- **September 27th thru October 6th**
~West of Main Street and continue into West Jefferson Township
- **October 6th thru October 15th**
~East of Main Street and continue into East Jefferson Township

***** Flushing will take place between***
7:30 AM and 4:00 PM**

The City of Celina is conducting a comprehensive flushing program to insure fire hydrants are operational and to clear out minerals that have accumulated in the city's water pipes. The flushing is accomplished by inspecting and opening fire hydrants fully. This is necessary to maintain the integrity of the distribution system and improve water quality.

Water service may be interrupted. If you see flushing in your area, it is recommended that you not use water for 1-2 hours to allow the system to clear. If water appears discolored, don't be alarmed. Run **cold** water through a faucet (exterior or bathtub preferred) approximately 5 minutes, to verify water has cleared.

If the water does not clear within a few hours, notify the Utility Office by calling 419-586-2311, Monday thru Friday between 8 AM and 5 PM.

RESIDENTIAL LEAF COLLECTION

The City of Celina residential leaf pickup will begin on October 19, 2021 and run weekly through December 10, 2021.

- Leaves are collected Tuesday through Friday in accordance with the established schedule and as weather conditions allow.
- Leaves must be placed at the curb.
- Avoid parking vehicles in the street during the collection period in your area. Do not park cars in or adjacent to any pile(s) of leaves.
- Do not mix branches with leaves. Limbs and branches collection will not begin until Spring 2022.

LEAF PICKUP SCHEDULE



- TUESDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street north.
- WEDNESDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street south.
- THURSDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street south.
- FRIDAY** Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street north.
