As part of our Street Resurfacing & Reconstruction program, Shelley Company began resurfacing nearly 11 miles of city streets as we forge into warmer weather. Additionally, Fulton Street is currently undergoing complete reconstruction, including water main replacement, curbs, and the majority of sidewalks. July 1st is the date for bidding out the reconstruction of Johnson Avenue and the downtown block of East Fayette Street. These projects are only possible with the .5% Supplemental Income Tax that fund the right-of-way improvements of our community's infrastructure. We should all take pride in our community!

At long last, Pickleball Courts are under construction in Eastview Park, adjacent to Montgomery Field. There will be a total of four (4) courts that will be able to accommodate multiple teams. A new full-length basketball court is under construction just off Elm Grove Street in the Bryson Park District and with installation of a portion of the walkway that will host a proposed "Fit Trail". Finally, with the generous donations of our local Lion's Club, individuals, and ODNR matching grant, a new shelter house/restroom facility will be constructed on South Ash Street to replace the existing Lion's Club shelter existing restroom facilities at North Shore Park.

Exciting developments continue to happen in Celina! Celina's Downtown continues to create fun events to encourage people to explore our community while supporting our local businesses!

Hydrant Flushing Schedule (dead ends only)

The City of Celina will be flushing at various locations to insure fire hydrants are operational and to clear out minerals that have accumulated in the city's water pipes. The flushing is accomplished by inspecting and opening fire hydrants fully. This is necessary to maintain the integrity of the distribution system and improve water quality.

Flushing will be conducted between 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM per the following schedule:

May 31st to June 3rd

Water service may be interrupted. If you see flushing in your area, it is recommended that you not use water for 1-2 hours to allow the system to clear. If water appears discolored, don't be alarmed. Run cold water through a faucet (exterior or bathtub preferred) approximately 5 minutes, to verify water has cleared.

If the water does not clear within a few hours, notify the Utility Office by calling 419-586-2311, Monday through Friday between 8 AM and 5 PM.

Brush & Limb Pickup



The City's residential limbs and brush collection will begin Monday, April 4th and be conducted on the first Monday of the month through October.

Only limbs and brush without root balls will be collected. Limbs and brush are not to be placed adjacent to the street earlier than three (3) days prior to the scheduled collection, nor after the street has been collected. An effort should be made by all to keep our community looking neat. Limbs must be stacked in piles with larger sections of limbs facing the same direction.

A three cubic yard limit has been established for each residence per pickup. That is equal to a pile three feet wide by three feet high by nine feet long.

Brush and limbs in excess of the three cubic yard limit will not be collected and are the responsibility of the property owner to dispose of.

City crews will make only one trip through the City each month and, once your neighborhood is collected, will not return until the next regularly scheduled collection. You are prohibited from putting brush, limbs or debris on the street.

IF YOU HAVE YOUR TREES TRIMMED, YOUR CONTRACTOR MUST REMOVE THE LIMBS/BRUSH.
